Welcome to Sports Creek Raceway

Whether this is your first visit to the track or you have been here before, we think you will find this brochure informative and entertaining.

Many people are intrigued by the thrills and excitement of horse racing but are unsure of the jargon and techniques of wagering. This brochure will give you basic information about how to bet. We can't guarantee that you will go home "in the money" but we can help you learn the basics of betting and add to the enjoyment of your visit to Sports Creek Raceway.

Picking



Winner

To place a bet, you will want a copy of an official racing program, which is available at the program stand. You will want to pick a program for whatever track you would like to watch & wager. The program lists the races for the day, the names of the horses, their numbers, background information, etc... The program provides a great deal of in-depth information of value to the person betting.



Types of Bets

There are several types of bets to choose from. Some are simple with a lower amount of risk & generally provide smaller payoffs. Other bets are more involved, present a higher level of risk, but offer the possibility of larger payoffs.

Remember, you can bet on as many horses as you like in any given race. Your bet must be made in whole dollar amounts. For example, you can bet \$2, \$3, \$5, \$10, \$12, but you can't bet \$3.50.

Basic Wagers



Win Bet:

Your horse must finish 1st to collect.



Place Bet:



Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd to collect.



Show Bet:



Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd to collect.



Daily Double

You must pick the winners of 2 consecutive races to collect. The daily double in a racing program is usually the first and second races. You must place your bet before the first half of the daily double. Be sure to check the official daily program for information about the daily doubles.

Perfecta

You must pick the horses that finish 1st & 2nd in the same race to collect. You must also pick the exact order in which the 2 horses finish. You can lower your risk when playing a perfecta by placing a 2nd perfecta bet and reversing the numbers of the horses you pick to finish 1st & 2nd. You collect if either combination of your 2 horses comes in 1st or 2nd. This is called boxing. You can box as many horses as you want in any given race.



Trifecta

You must pick the horses that finish 1st, 2nd, & 3rd in the exact order, in the same race, to collect. Be sure to check our official daily programs for races on which you can make trifecta bets. Trifecta boxes are also available.

How to Bet

Until you become familiar and comfortable with betting, it is a good idea to place your bets on a race early. Also, for your convenience and that of your fellow race track patrons, have your selections made before you approach a betting window.

By following this procedure, you will be able to place your bet quickly and easily. When you reach the teller window,

TELL THE CLERK

1. Track Name
2. Race #...(Second Race)
3. How much you want to bet...(\$2.00)
4. Type of bet...(Win, Place, Show, Daily Double, Perfecta, or Trifecta)
5. The program # of the horse, or horses, on which you are Betting...(#2)

Example:

"Sports Creek, 2nd Race, \$2 to Win on #2 Horse."

The Odds

Odds you see on the TV monitors are set by the bettors themselves. They are based on the money bet on each horse in the win pool only. Each horse's odds are determined by the ratio of how much money has been bet to win on all the horses in that race. The "Morning Lines", which appear in the official daily program, are odds set by professional Bookmakers before betting actually begins. These odds are simply educated guesses as to how the public will bet on each horse. The "Morning Line" may differ significantly from the final odds, so it is important to keep track of the actual odds on the TV monitors.

Boxing & Wheeling the Perfecta, Trifecta, & Superfecta

BOX

A box includes every possible combination that could result from the horses selected. You collect on a perfecta box if any 2 selected horses finish 1st or 2nd in either order. You collect on a trifecta box if any 3 selected horses finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in any order. You collect on a superfecta box if any 4 selected horses finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th in any order.

Wheel

Select a "KEY" horse you feel is going to win and play it with all other possible combinations. If your "KEY" horse wins the race, you win your bet regardless of which horses finish in the other positions. You may also wheel a horse in the place and show positions. In wheeling a horse, if your "KEY" horse finishes in the position that you have selected, you win your bet, no matter which horses finish in the other positions. You can also select a "KEY" horse to finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd and wheel it with several horses (a partial wheel) instead of the entire field.
